Today's Gospel says, "Whoever believes in me [Jesus] will do the works that I do, and will do greater..." The works of Jesus included welcoming, consoling, healing, loving, forgiving, breaking down racial and gender barriers and manifesting God's presence in action and word. How are we doing the work of Christian discipleship? In what ways are we manifesting the presence of God?
