Meeting May 18, 2017

Meeting held in the Driscoll/Murphy Room with Father James present. Reflection offered by Mike Duncan on John 14. "The Spirit is Truth and is with us".

Lukefest plans are well underway with Mike Duncan leading again this year. The first place prize is in place; tickets on the truck will be ready for distribution in July. There are many opportunities for volunteering.

Child care plans are moving ahead with plans for implementation in the fall. A ministry with a coordinator is under consideration.

PAC continues to identify candidates for discernment with orientation planned in early August. Departing members Bill Booth, David Glorioso, and Mary Jo Dovale were thanked for their service.

Doug Weissbruch attended and introduced the concept of a parish endowment to provide a vehicle for major donations that would be invested and grow to provide a corpus that could spin off a small percentage each year for special parish needs. Currently there is not a good vehicle for memorial gifts. The council was in consensus and will move the issue to the Finance Committee.

V Encuentro is a new diocesan wide evangelization program initiated by the Council of American Bishops. Coordinators of the current parish evangelization program are now studying this for implementation.
